## **I'm Being Exploited**

'I'm Being Exploited' is a powerful short film launched by the [Northamptonshire Safeguarding Children Partnership](#) (NSCP), and produced in conjunction with Northamptonshire Police and partners across Northamptonshire, to raise awareness to parents of a growing issue in the UK – known as 'Child Exploitation' (CE).

Child Exploitation is when a child or young person is targeted by an individual or criminal gang and manipulated or coerced into committing crimes or sexual acts.

**This film seeks to help parents and other trusted adults spot the signs of a problem, and highlight the crucial part they can play by taking appropriate action.**

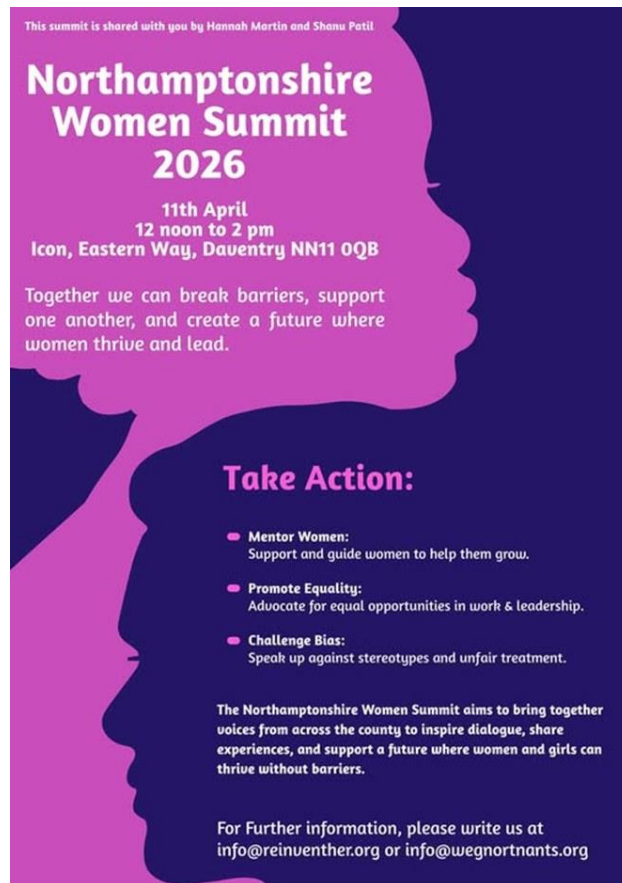

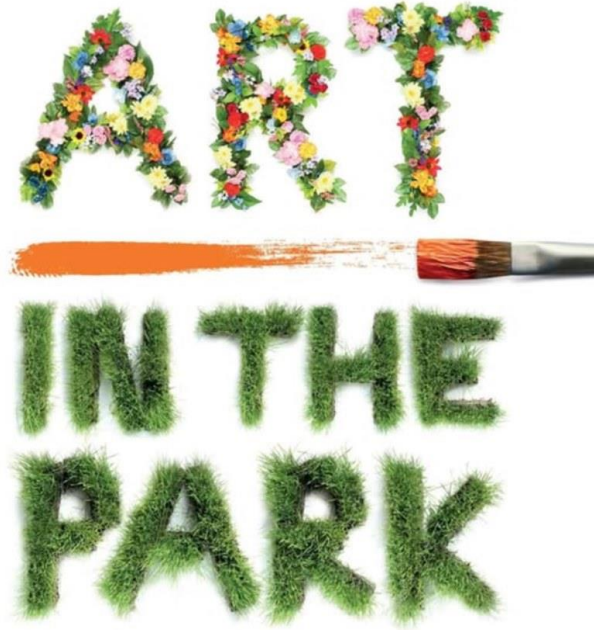

- Signpost and connect families to additional support services as needed

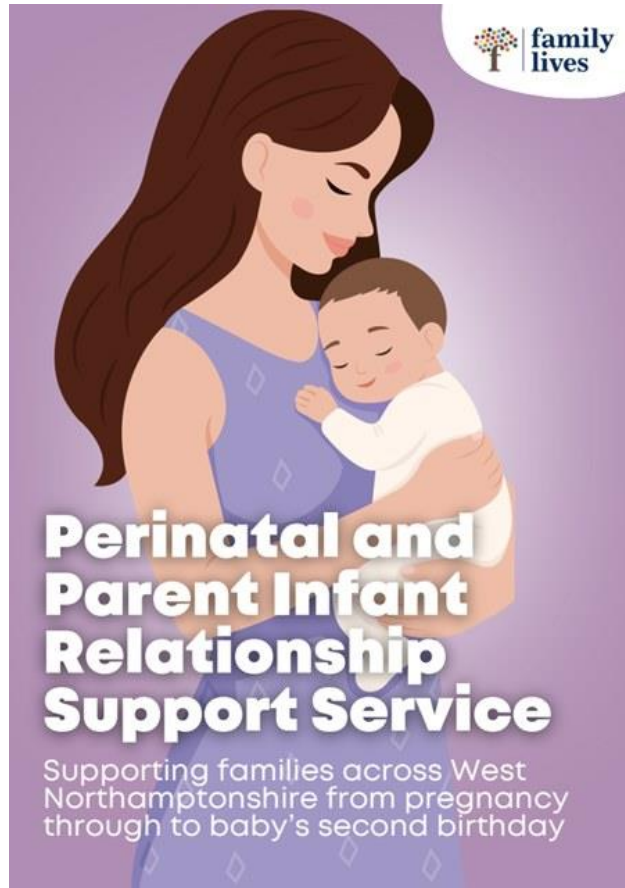
