Fire Cadet Programme - open for applications

Northamptonshire Fire and Rescue Service has opened applications for its Fire Cadet programme, inviting young people across the county to challenge themselves, learn new skills and become part of a team that makes a real difference in the community.

The Fire Cadets programme offers hands-on experience of what it is like to be a part of a Fire and Rescue Service.

Through weekly sessions held at fire stations across Northamptonshire, Cadets will develop practical skills, leadership abilities and personal confidence in a supportive team environment.

Alongside learning practical firefighting skills, Fire Cadets play an active role in the community. The Cadets have the opportunity to attend local and national events, sharing safety advice and demonstrating the methods used by firefighters to protect the public.

Young people aged between 13 – 17 are invited to apply. Applicants must be able to commit to attending one session a week during term time, and a minimum of six community events per year.

No prior experience is needed – just enthusiasm, commitment and a willingness to learn.

To apply, fill out an application form online. If applicants are successful, they will be invited to join an assessment centre where they will take part in an interview, team activities and practical tasks.

What is a Healthy Start card?

What is Healthy Start? If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under 4, you may be entitled to get help to buy healthy food and milk.

If you're eligible, you'll be sent a Healthy Start card with money on it that you can use in some UK shops. We'll add your benefit onto this card every 4 weeks.

You can use your card to buy:

- plain liquid cow's milk
- fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
- fresh, dried, and tinned pulses
- infant formula milk based on cow's milk

You can also use your card to collect:

Healthy Start vitamins – these support you during pregnancy and breastfeeding

vitamin drops for babies and young children – these are suitable from birth to 4 years old

I'm Being Exploited

'I'm Being Exploited' is a powerful short film launched by the [Northamptonshire Safeguarding Children Partnership](#) (NSCP), and produced in conjunction with Northamptonshire Police and partners across Northamptonshire, to raise awareness to parents of a growing issue in the UK – known as 'Child Exploitation' (CE).

Child Exploitation is when a child or young person is targeted by an individual or criminal gang and manipulated or coerced into committing crimes or sexual acts.

This film seeks to help parents and other trusted adults spot the signs of a problem, and highlight the crucial part they can play by taking appropriate action.

The McCarthy Dixon Foundation **Mobile Community Shop** helps bring low-cost food and everyday essentials directly into local communities across Northamptonshire. Using our specially adapted van, we visit different locations each week, making it easier for people to pick up fresh produce, cupboard staples, toiletries and household items closer to home.

How it works

As this is still a new service, we wanted to explain how it works. Instead of pricing every item individually, most products are given a points value between 1 and 5. Customers can buy **9 points for £5** or **18 points for £10**, then use those points to choose the items they need. Most everyday essentials are only 1 or 2 points, and we also offer **pre-packed fresh fruit and vegetable bags for £2.50**.
