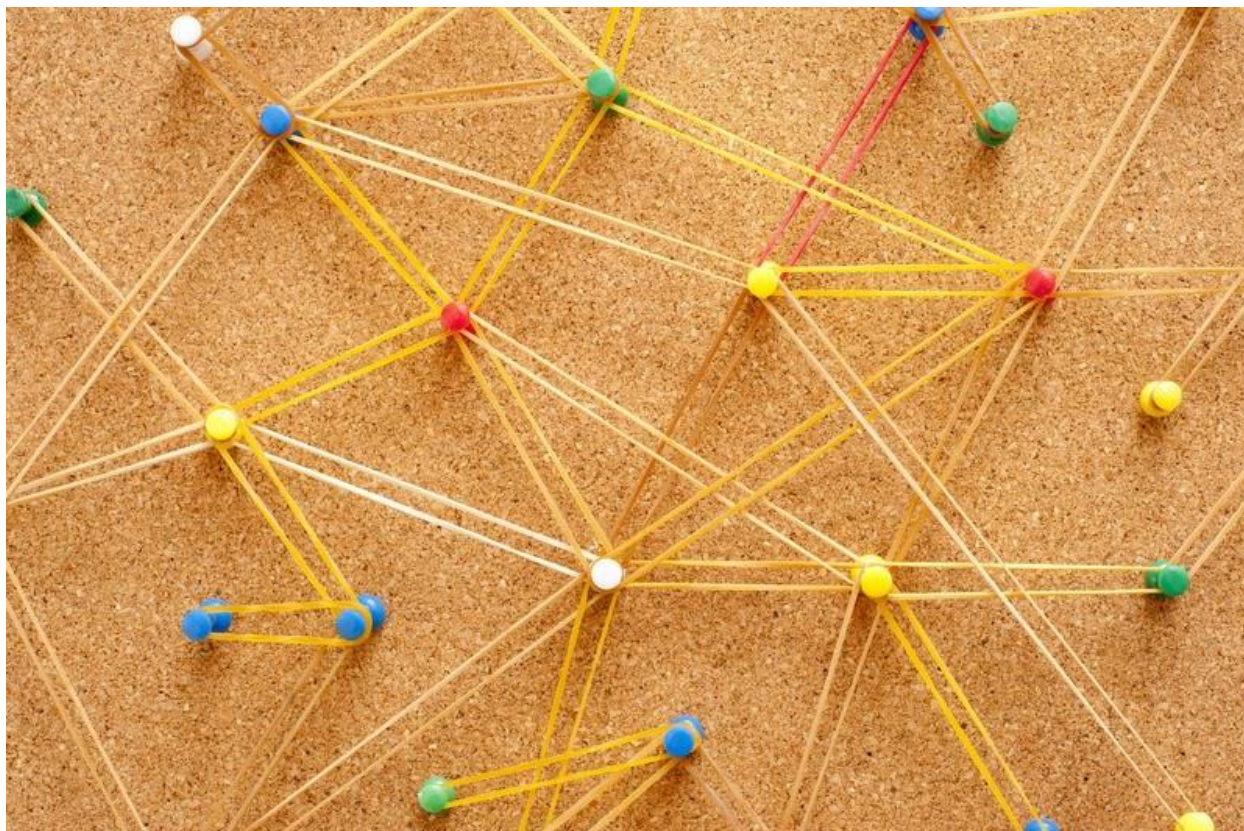




West Northamptonshire Stay Connected August 2026

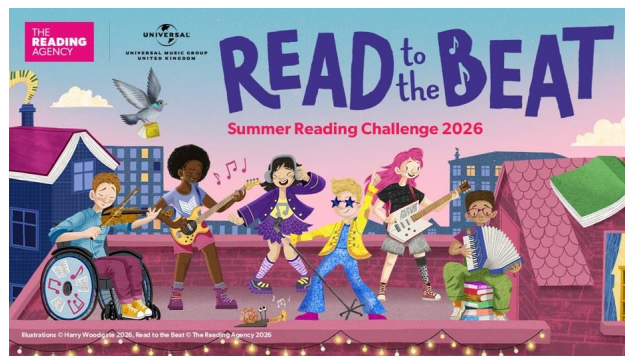
For anyone who hasn't visited us before, just email your local library and request a specifically created Summer Reading Challenge social stories so you know what to expect before you walk through the door!

How it works

As this is still a new service, we wanted to explain how it works. Instead of pricing every item individually, most products are given a points value between 1 and 5. Most everyday essentials are only 1 or 2 points, and we also offer **pre-packed fresh fruit and vegetable bags for £2.50**.
