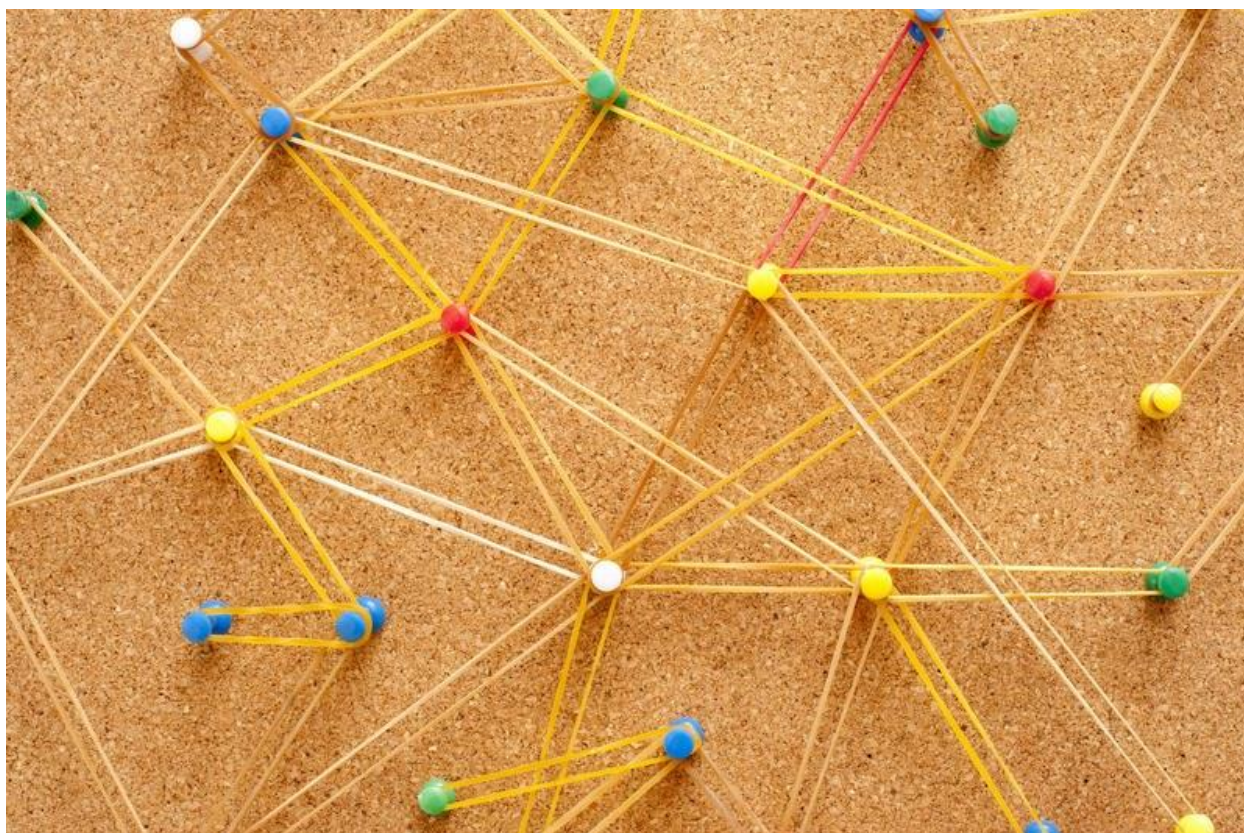

Eyes Wide Open - Online safety video for parents

The Police launched their 'Eyes Wide Open' campaign around online safety for children earlier in July. If you are a parent of a teenager or younger child, we highly recommend reading this resource. We also encourage you to share it within your communities to help raise awareness.

The Eyes Wide Open campaign, a one-minute video, played by actors, aims to raise awareness of the harm that young children can be exposed to while online and encourages parents to have conversations with their children, while setting appropriate online and device restrictions to help protect them.

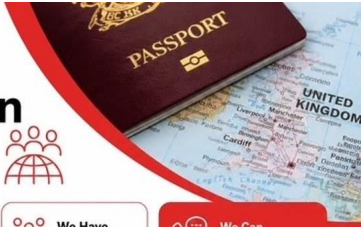

Apply to our free Creative Development Programme.

The Creative Place. October to December 2026. Online or in person Open to anyone 16 years or older with no upper limit.

Can you apply?

1. Are you 16 years or older and living in Northamptonshire?
2. Are you neurodivergent, disabled (Physical or learning disability), Deaf or a person living with disabilities or autistic?
3. Are you an Artist or Creative person interested in one of these areas: Film and TV, Publishing, Art including Fine Art and Festivals, Advertising, Performing Arts, Fashion, craft, Music, Design, Arts & Culture like Museums and Libraries, Games
4. Are you wanting to work in one of these areas or at the beginning of your career?
5. Can you spend 8+ hours per month Oct-Dec working on your creative process? And would benefit from meeting other creatives?

If you answered yes, can you apply.

To apply you can: Write us an email. Send us a voicenote or video. Visit the creative place for a chat.

Tell us about: Yourself and your creativity.

What area you work in (e.g. Film). Something you want to work towards (e.g. something you want to improve on, a job you want to get or an event you would like to run).

Everyone that applies will be invited to 3 free sessions to develop your creativity. 6 people will take part in a 3 month process to develop as a Creative, working with mentors and using The Creative Place to test out your ideas. There is no cost. We will work with you to design the programme around your needs including in-person or remote.

Applications close 25 September or when we have received 35 applications. We may start allocating from 10 September. The Creative Place is the world's smallest arts centre on Northampton Market Square. It is run by non-profit Northampton Film Festival.

The McCarthy Dixon Foundation **Mobile Community Shop** helps bring low-cost food and everyday essentials directly into local communities across Northamptonshire. Using our

specially adapted van, we visit different locations each week, making it easier for people to pick up fresh produce, cupboard staples, toiletries and household items closer to home.

How it works

As this is still a new service, we wanted to explain how it works. Instead of pricing every item individually, most products are given a points value between 1 and 5. Customers can buy **9 points for £5** or **18 points for £10**, then use those points to choose the items they need. Most everyday essentials are only 1 or 2 points, and we also offer **pre-packed fresh fruit and vegetable bags for £2.50**.
